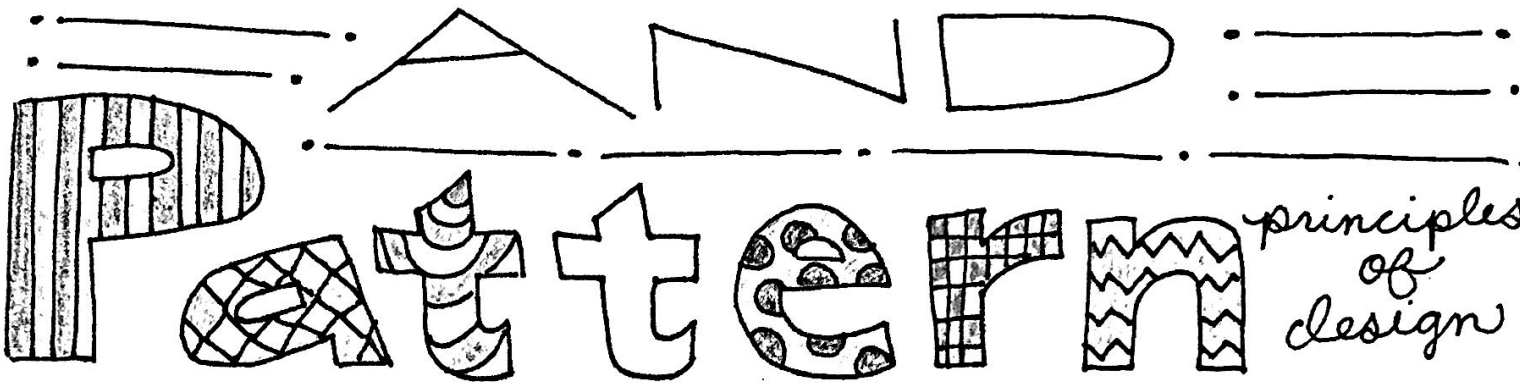
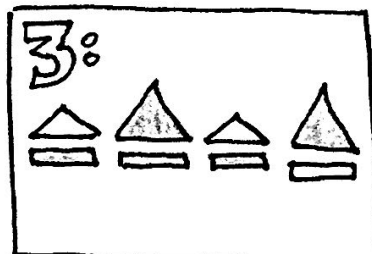
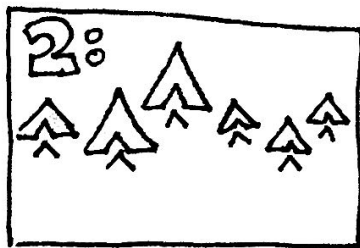
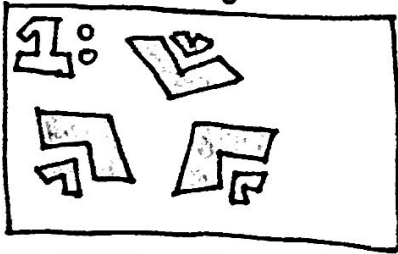


# REPETITION

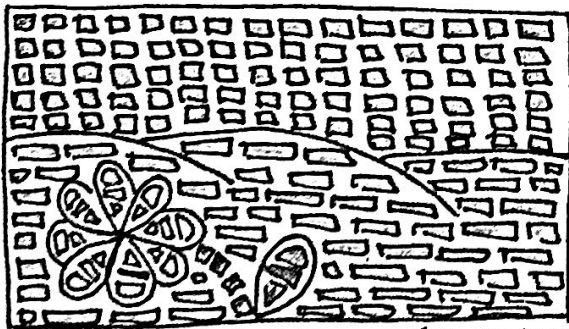


**Repetition:** can help UNIFY a work of art by REPEATING lines, shapes, colors, or other ELEMENTS OF ART. An element may only REPEAT once or multiple times to create RHYTHM or PATTERN



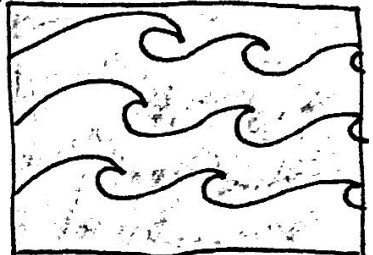
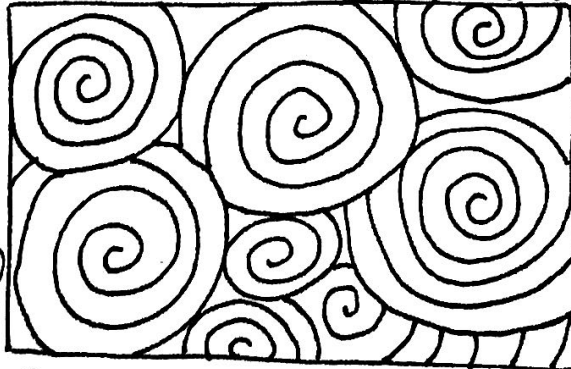
1: REPETITION

**Pattern:** elements that REPEAT in a PREDICTABLE way. a few types of PATTERN

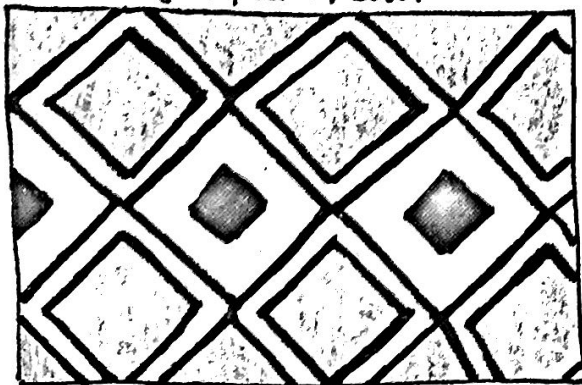


**MOSAIC:** small shapes (TESSERAE) make up a larger image. shapes are grouped by color.

**SPIRAL:** Round, curving shape also called volute (2D) or helix (3D)

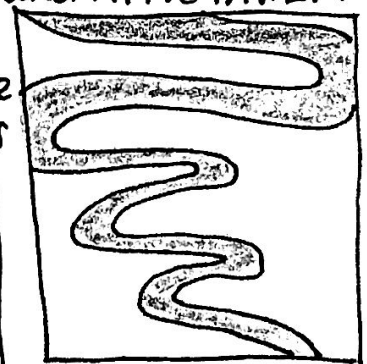
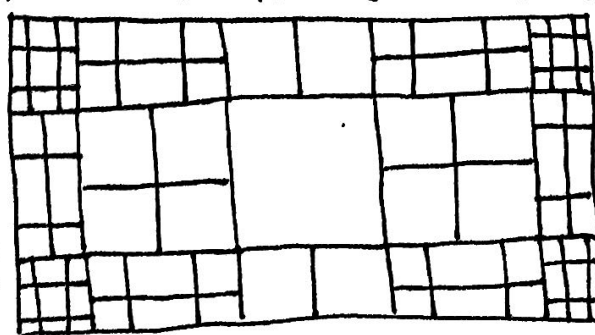


**WAVES:** regular repeating waves and ripple PATTERN

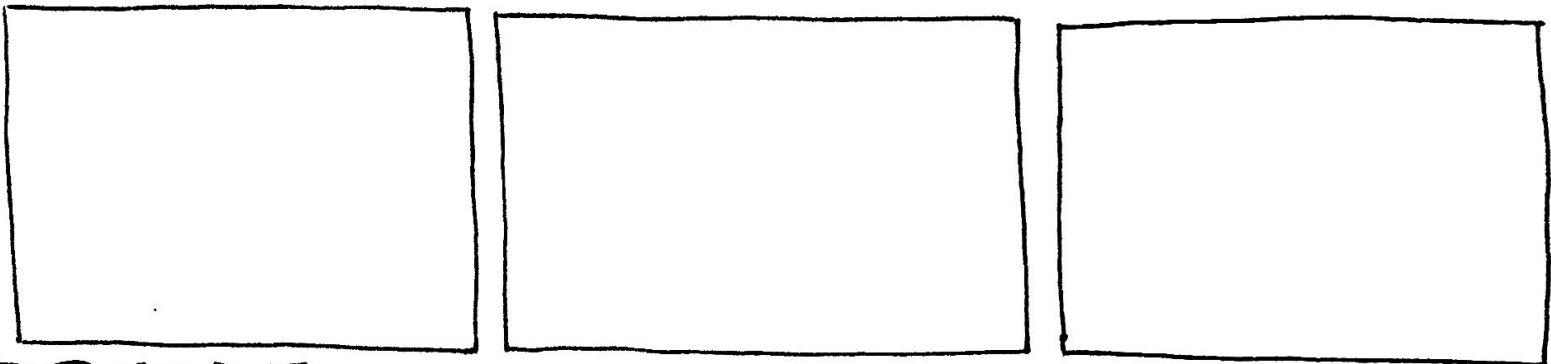


**SYMMETRICAL:** shapes that repeat the same way.

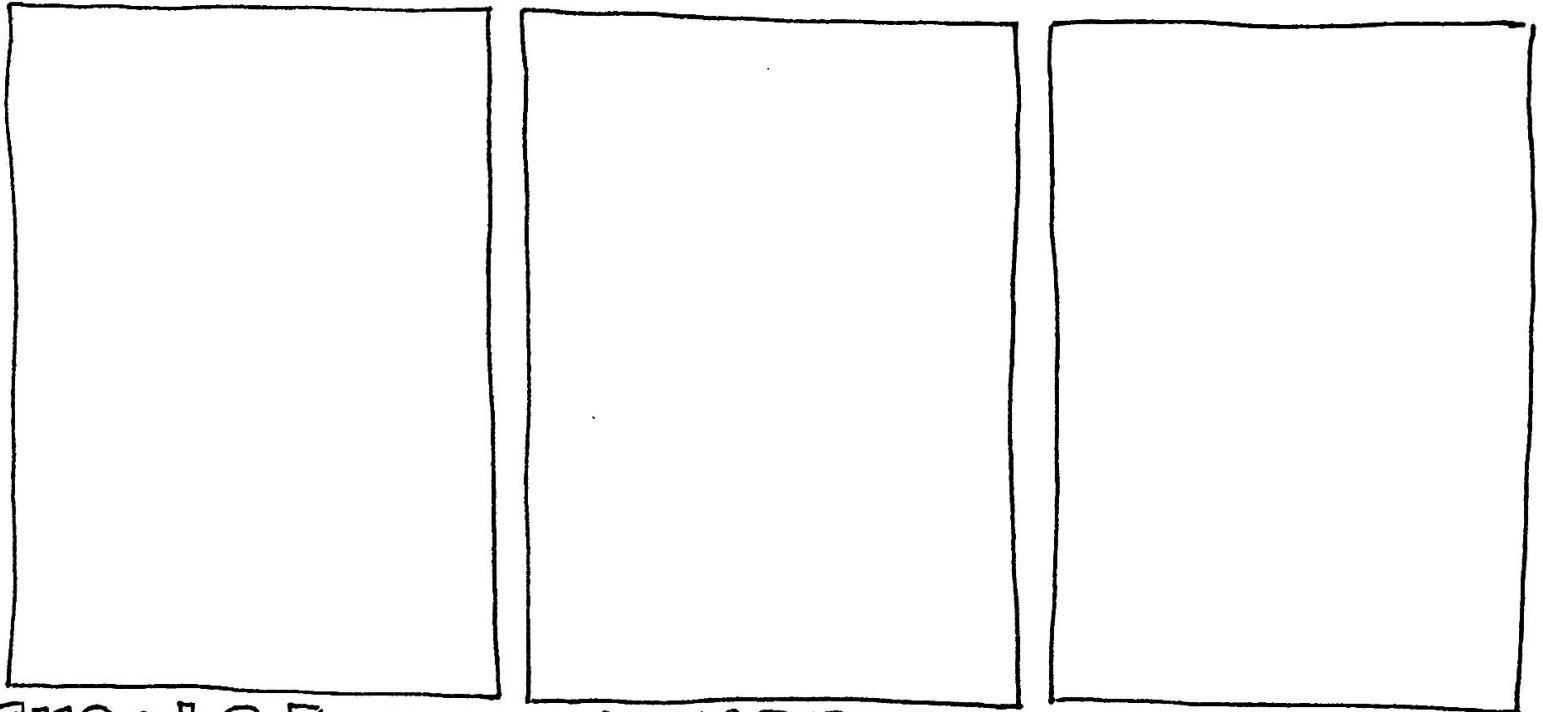
**FRACTALS:** shapes that divide into smaller versions of themselves



**MEANDER:** irregular wave or curved shapes
